

A12 LESSON ON OPPOSITES

You need to create a lesson on opposites and you forgot all your workbooks at school. However, using online content you can research, evaluate and adapt material for your classroom and because of the vast amount of information online, access to a hundred times more resources than you could store in a single classroom.

1) Visit the Enchanted Learning web site for online resources for teaching opposites:

2) Find one rhyme about **opposites** from this web site.

3) Find a **graphic organizer** about opposites that you would do as a group.

4) Find a **coloring page** for guided practice.

5) Open PowerPoint. Create your Title Slide.

6) Create a Slide to introduce your lesson on opposites.

7) Create your Rhyme slide (Copy and Paste your selected Rhyme here or write an original Rhyme with illustrations).

TIP: You may need more than one slide if your rhyme is too long –remember the 28 point minimum size for readability.

8) Create your graphic organizer slide. If you could not copy one from the web site, you may have to use the drawing tools (Oval and Line tools) to create your own graphic organizer. *TIP: You could include pictures in your organizer and print it out for additional guided practice.*

9) Create your coloring page. Copy and paste one coloring page from the web site. Include instructions and expectations for completion of the coloring activity.

10) Save your work- Print your slides as Handouts.

11) Make an additional Print out of your coloring page (Print the current slide only).
