

## **INDIVIDUAL LESSON ASSIGNMENTS RUBRIC**

There are three major components to the individual lesson assignment. The lesson plan, the materials and the assessment are all important to successful classroom teaching.

**LESSON PLAN-** A blueprint about the lesson and concepts you will teach. This is a teacher document and provides an overview of what will be done in your lesson, the benchmarks you will address, the resources needed and the organization of the lesson.

**LESSON MATERIALS-** A step by step guide for students to practice and reinforce learning with an activity. What you will use with students. Overhead transparencies, powerpoint slides, video clips, pictures, handouts, worksheets. Provide an actual example of the materials students will use in guided practice.

**ASSESSMENT RUBRIC-** How you can check for understanding. What you expect students to do and what you are looking for in the completion of the lesson. Use a table or a list to divide the student practice into steps that you can grade for completion, content and innovation.

ASSESSMENT RUBRIC- 3 points

0-1 Assignment Rubric missing or substantially incomplete

2 Assignment Rubric done but with mistakes or lack of connection

3 Assignment Rubric is well done and clear connection with Lesson Plan
